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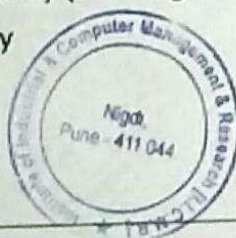
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202-Financial Management CCE- Story of the Month/Week (SDP)

Evaluation Parameters:

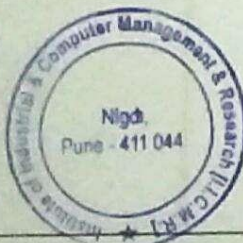
